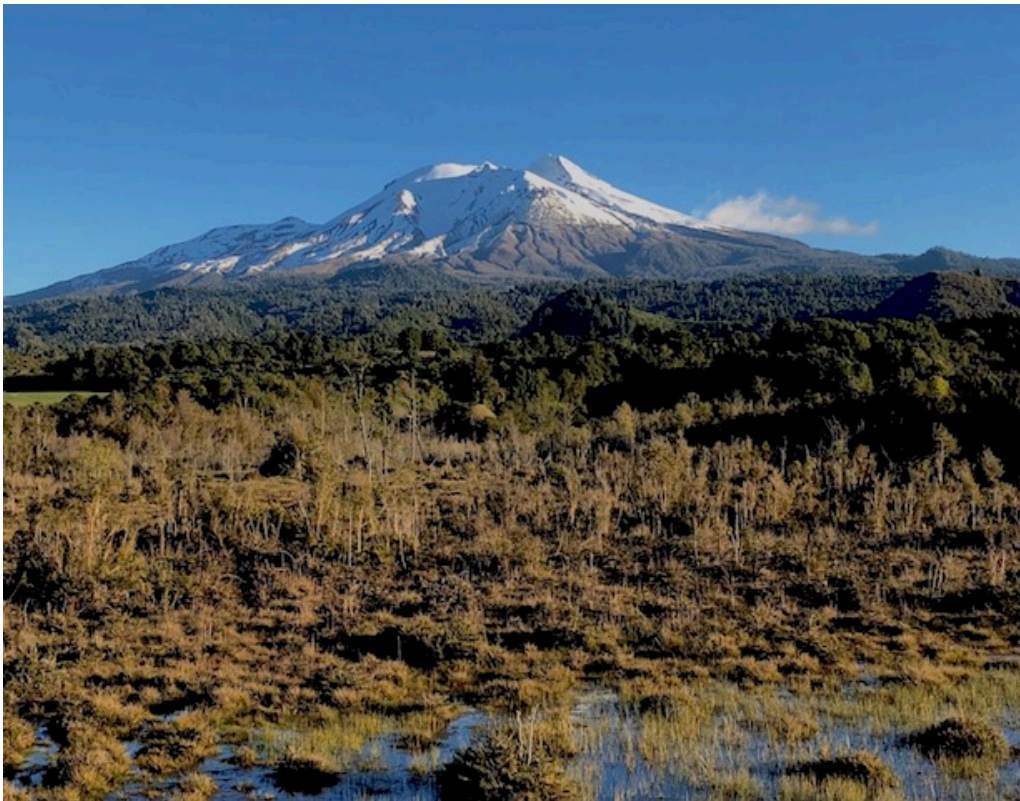




HIKE CALBUCO VOLCANO & WATERFALLS OF CASCADA Full Day



This exclusive adventure will take you through a wonderful hike at the foothills of the most active and spectacular volcano of Chile & the Lake District. Be a witness of the effects of a recent eruption is not an everyday experience! Our expert naturalist guides will take you through the paths of the natural history of the region hiking through the temperate

rainforest, basaltic formations, remains and traces of an eruption of only 3 years ago and, of course, learning about the adaption that every living being is having to survive in a brand new landscape and environment. The first hike will be at the Calbuco Volcano with an interpretation circuit of 4 kilometres (2 hours) at the foothills of the mountain. The second part will take place at the foothills of the Osorno Volcano with a trail of 4 kilometers through a dense patch of temperate rainforest to reach a spectacular waterfall fed by the ice melting from the volcano summit
